TEAM STRUCTURE:

3 Players per Team

Each team must have **minimum 1 Beginner Player**

The remaining 2 players can be either **Beginners or Intermediate Players**

Category	Definition
Beginner	1–3 months of playing experience
Intermediate	3–18 months may have played 1–2 city tournaments
Professional / National	NOT ELIGIBLE — see below

No Professional or National-level players are permitted under any circumstances. This includes players with professional tennis, squash, or racket sport backgrounds regardless of their padel experience.

Organiser's Discretion: The organiser reserves the right to reclassify any player based on playing history, observed skill level, or prior competitive background — regardless of stated category. This decision is final.

REGISTRATION FEES:

Tier	Fee per Team	Eligibility
Early Bird	INR 12,000	Teams registered before 10th May 2026
Regular	INR 15,000	All subsequent registrations

Registration fees are non-refundable. Spots confirmed on receipt of payment only. Teams may not substitute players on the day without prior organiser approval.

PRIZE MONEY:

Winner: INR 50,000

1st Runner-Up: INR 15,000

Prize money distributed within 7 days of the event, subject to verification of eligibility. Winners must present valid ID and bank details on the day.

WHAT IS A TIE?

A **Tie** is the full encounter between two teams. Each Tie consists of **2 doubles matches**. All 3 players on each team rotate across the 2 matches — no player sits out the entire Tie. The team that wins **more matches** wins the Tie.

Player Rotation

Match	Team A Pair	Team B Pair
1	Players 1 & 2	Players 1 & 2
2	Players 2 & 3 OR Players 1 & 3	Players 2 & 3 OR Players 1 & 3

Captains must declare both pairs for both matches to the referee before the Tie begins. The pair for Match 2 may not be changed after declaration, regardless of the Match 1 result. Rotation may not be changed once declared.

SCORING FORMAT:

Match Format

Each match is played as a **single set to 6 games**

Points within games follow standard padel scoring: **15, 30, 40, game**. At deuce (40–40), a sudden-death deciding point is played

At 6–6 → **tiebreak to 7 points** (must win by 2)

Officiating: Matches are self-officiated. A tournament supervisor will be present for all disputes. Disputes must be raised with the supervisor before the next point is played. Supervisor decisions are final.

Group Stage Points

Two separate tallies are kept. **Standings points** are used for the table. **Match wins** are used only as a tiebreaker.

Result	Standings Points
Win a Tie (2-0)	2 points
Drawn Tie (1-1)	1 point each team
Lose a Tie (0-2)	0 points
Win an individual match	1 match win recorded (tiebreaker only)

Group Rankings — Tiebreaker Order

Priority	Criterion
1	Total standings points
2	Total individual match wins across all Ties
3	Game difference (games won minus games lost)
4	Head-to-head result between tied teams
5	Coin toss by the match referee

LEAGUE FORMAT:

Group Stage → Knockout

16 teams divided into **4 groups of 4 teams**

Each group plays a full Round Robin — every team faces every other team

Top 2 teams from each group advance to the Knockout Stage

Knockout Round	Teams	Format
Quarter Finals	8 (top 2 per group)	Single set to 6 games
Semi Finals	4	Single set to 6 games
Final	2	Single set to 6 games

Knockout Ties follow the same 2-match format with player rotation as the Group Stage. In the event of a 1–1 split after 2 matches, a Super Tiebreak is played — one doubles tiebreak to 10 points (win by 2) between nominated pairs from each team. Captains declare their Super Tiebreak pair to the referee immediately after match 2.

SUBSTITUTIONS & INJURIES:

All 3 registered players must be available at the start of the event.

Player substitutions after registration closes are **not permitted** without organiser approval.

If a player is injured **before a Tie begins**, the team may withdraw from that Tie (walkover to opponents). The team may continue in subsequent Ties with remaining players subject to organiser discretion.

If a player is injured **mid-match**, standard walkover rules apply — the match is awarded to the opposing pair. The injured player may not return in that Tie.

A player may not leave and re-enter a match once it has begun.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

All players must check in at least **30 minutes before their first Tie**.

Teams not at court within **10 minutes of scheduled Tie time** forfeit the Tie.

Padel-specific footwear is mandatory on court.

Rackets and balls are provided; players may use their own rackets.

Coaching from the sidelines is not permitted during a match.

Verbal abuse, intimidation, or unsportsmanlike conduct results in **immediate disqualification**.

All referee and tournament director decisions are **final**.

Teams found violating eligibility rules will be **disqualified without refund**.

The organiser reserves the right to modify the schedule for unforeseen circumstances.
